Protective measures will be taken to assure that all collections are respectfully guarded from harm, but neither the City Reliquary, nor Union Pool can be held responsible for any damage or loss of your belongings.

Your Expectations:

Presenters will be expected to transport and install their collections at Union Pool during the set-up time of 4:00 to 5:00 PM on Sunday April 9th. All displays will be de-installed and removed from the premises that night between 10:00 and 11:00 PM. A table (apx. 3'x 6') will be provided on-site for you to display your objects.

Suggestions:

Please think of creative ways to display your collection. Imagine a school science fair filled with tables of interesting displays. In fact, you may choose to use the standard school fair tri-fold display board, which is available at many art supply stores. A cardboard backdrop can be used to display flat items, background information, or titles and informative labels. Some other suggestions are: small boxes to raise objects, fabric to drape over table tops, glass or plexi vitrines, pins, clips, labels, extra lights, and extension cords.
